- Goal: workforce development + public health effort.
- Focus on recruiting people who are unemployed and from communities most impacted by COVID-19.
- Progress: received more than 7,000 applications, most of the staff have been selected and hired.







Pathways Tracks

Community Health Pathways AmeriCorps members serve in one of four roles:



Violence Prevention Coordinator, CHW

Implement trauma-informed care strategies, provide safety planning and follow-up services to violence-impacted individuals, and guide affected community members to support while working towards your CHW certification.



Mental Health Advocate, Healing City

Use a healing-centered, trauma-informed approach to provide compassionate, culturally relevant peer support and help the community access wraparound services for community members navigating complex support systems.



Community Health Assistant, CNA or CHW

Improve access and quality of care for underserved communities while training to become a certified nursing assistant (CNA) or community health worker (CHW). As a CNA, you'll provide care for patients at homes, hospitals, and other facilities under the direction of a nurse. As a CHW, you'll connect communities to vital health and social services.



Community Resource Connector, Healing City

Help community members access the resources and services they need to thrive by addressing social determinants of health. In this role, you may serve in a health, housing, financial opportunity or justice related organization.
