



Southland Challenges

- Small, under-resourced school districts
- Weak, often corrupt, local government
- Limited human services infrastructure
- Few philanthropic resources

Southland Strengths

- Strong "grasstops" leaders.
- Committed school leaders with Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) knowledge/orientation.
- Existing relationships and social trust developed by Governors State University.
- Proximity to Chicago human services and funding streams.

Southland "Community Organizing" Approach

- Build around leaders and their interests/what they care most about.
- Invest heavily in training and capacity building.
- Shape strong "Resilience Teams" to direct the work at the district/school level.
- Look for early wins to build momentum.
- Operate with minimal structure and bureaucracy: "Low overhead = high independence."
