



GUN VIOLENCE IS A PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS THAT AFFECTS US ALL

The U.S. government, private organizations and research institutions have long recognized violence as a public health* issue that should be treated as any other disease. As recently as June 2024, the US Surgeon General declared gun violence to be a public health crisis. Yet, the narrative of gun violence in the U.S. (based on policing, punitive measures and racist beliefs) lags behind the reality.



By spreading this New Narrative we can influence others to address the root causes of gun violence.

Instead of addressing only the symptoms of violence with punishment and control, this model focuses on its root causes: the social, legal and economic systems that create the conditions for violence to occur. This holistic approach recognizes that gun violence isn't just an issue for Black people, or poor people, it's a crisis that has meaning and consequences for all of us.

When we successfully share the New Narrative, people will be able to see how these solutions work, why they work, and the safe, healthy, and hopeful communities they can help us achieve.

WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN?

A comprehensive public safety plan is a **written document**, that includes the long-term vision for those most impacted by community violence, along with **goals** and **action steps** to achieve that vision.

It has **publicly identified goal owners**, timelines to achieve each goal and an **accountability structure**.

It is the **developed in partnership with** key partners from community, government, philanthropy, business, and most importantly **those who have been most impacted**.

At Cities United, we work with communities to **build this** plan into a strategy, a strategy that informs the **ecosystem**.






WHAT IS A COMPREHENSIVE PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN?
